


How to Print the London Class Pattern

Thank you for choosing this Beverly Johnson Designs. If you have never used a digital pattern before, help is here. **PLEASE, open the pattern files on a computer where the file can be saved, as they can be downloaded only 3 times.** You must open the files with Adobe Acrobat Reader available for free at <https://www.adobe.com/ca/acrobat/pdf-reader.html>

The whole pattern file set consists of:

- Sewing instructions for each View of London, a cover page and supply list.
- Three pattern files: individual pages for each size, a large format for all sizes to take to a copy shop and finally a projector file for all sizes. You can print on either letter size or A4 paper.
- A YouTube link to the video classes.

1. To make sure your printer is printing exactly to size, print off page 1 ONLY to test the printer. The test box is 4" (10.2 cm) square. On the PRINT page, make sure the size is set to **Actual size** and the orientation is set to **Auto**. Clicking Auto ensures that the pattern box will be centered on your paper. If the 4" scale box on page 1 does NOT measure to the correct measurements, adjust your printer to either 99% or 101% in **Custom Scale** and test again.



2. Here is a chart to locate your BCD size and the pages you need. You don't need to print off all the pages - print only the pages you need for your size.

5. Trim off the excess paper along the right and bottom of the pages (no need to trim off all 4 borders). Tape the pages together, matching the triangles to form a diamond. Most pattern pieces use only 1 page, except for the largest / longest pieces and/or sizes.
